Short description of work experience	<p>Gabriel Amitsis is Associate Professor of Social Security Law in the Department of Business Administration at the Technological Educational Institute of Athens. He has undertaken research and teaching since 1998 at the Greek Open University, the Athens National School of Public Administration and the Hellenic National Centre for Social Research in areas relating to EU and comparative employment, social security and inclusion policies, while he is a Visiting Professor of Social Law & Policy in the Nicosia University (Head of PhD and M.A. Programme on Public Administration).</p> <p>Dr. Amitsis practices law in civil and administrative cases concerning the protection of human and social rights; he also serves as senior social policy consultant on behalf of national administrations and International Organizations, while he is a key expert of EU and national projects on social welfare and migration. He was commissioned by the Greek government as the senior policy expert for “<i>The Green Paper on the National Social Inclusion Strategy</i>” (Ministry of Labour, Social Insurance and Welfare, 2013-2014) and the Coordinator of the <i>National Social Inclusion Strategy</i> (adopted by the European Commission in January 2015).</p> <p>He is the Coordinator of the Greek Chapter of the Academics Stand Against Poverty Network, an international association focused on helping researchers and academic teachers enhance their impact on poverty. His main research interests focus on the regulation of social security, anti-poverty, employment, social entrepreneurship and migration policies; he is author and co-author of twenty books and has published in international edited books and journals.
