- To foster knowledge- and experience-sharing and capacity-building on successful action to increase third country nationals' participation in society, with a particular focus on **social activities, cultural life, sport, media professions, decision-making/consultation** and **representation frameworks**.



HOW WE WANT TO ACHIEVE THE OBJECTIVES?

The project proposal '**Welcome Home**'

Aims to set-up a transnational network to stimulate innovative approaches and to facilitate exchanges of best practices and capacity-building with a particular focus on the integrating dimension of housing providers.

Planned activities

- ✓ Conduct a comparative study on how national legislations deal with refugees'
- ✓ Gather an overview of lessons learned in Europe on Housing and Integration;
- ✓ Create an 'Online Knowledge Hub'
- ✓ Video interviews with individuals living in the homes in order to give them a platform to tell their stories;
- ✓ Compile a list of enabling factors for successful projects;
- ✓ Prepare a checklist for measures required from local, national and regional and European authorities;
- ✓ Propose a European action plan on local integration;
- ✓ Organise 3 national conferences and 1 pan-EU conference;
