For 2 years EMH develops by its service of R&D, an approach "On the accommodation of tomorrow" which questions us about our everyday life:

What will be the needs in the accommodation of tomorrow in term of uses and comfort for 2030?

- The problem of the summer comfort is certainly going to become more important than that of winter.
- Problem of humidity and of quality of air in the accommodation.
- The support of the ageing tenants.
- Our needs in energy to answer in our new, more and more connected lifestyle.

We think that it is necessary to approach the problem of NZEB on the scale of our needs of tomorrow and not only to those of today.
