Feature of the housing construction 1970 - 2005

Technology	1970	1980	1990	1994	1995	2003	2005
Panel building (prefabricated)	70%	89%	98%	76%	20%	4%	3%

1958 – 1990 nearly 1,2 million flats were built under prefab technologies in all areas of today's Czech Republic

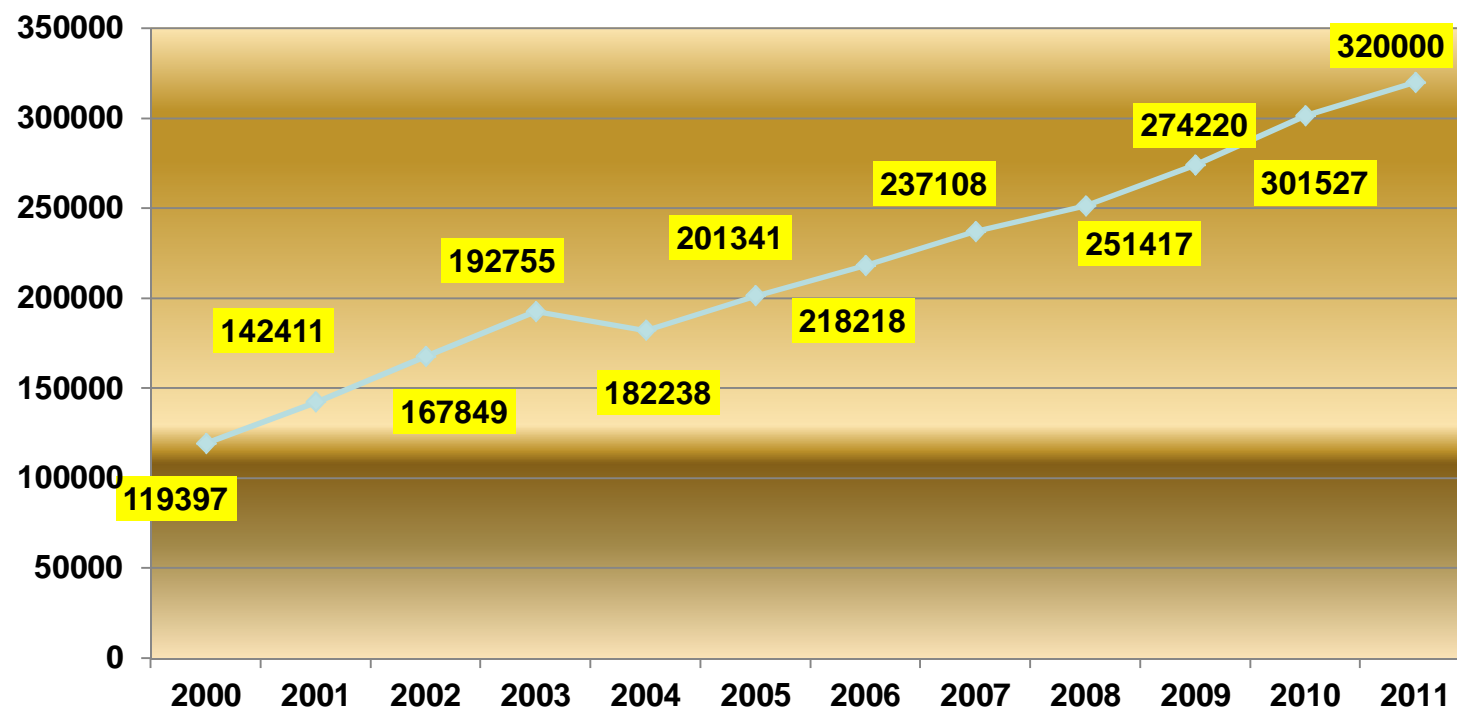
(Total housing stock: 3,9 mil. permanently occupied dwellings)

Political and economic changes after November 1989

New legislation especially the Civic Code and the Commercial Code

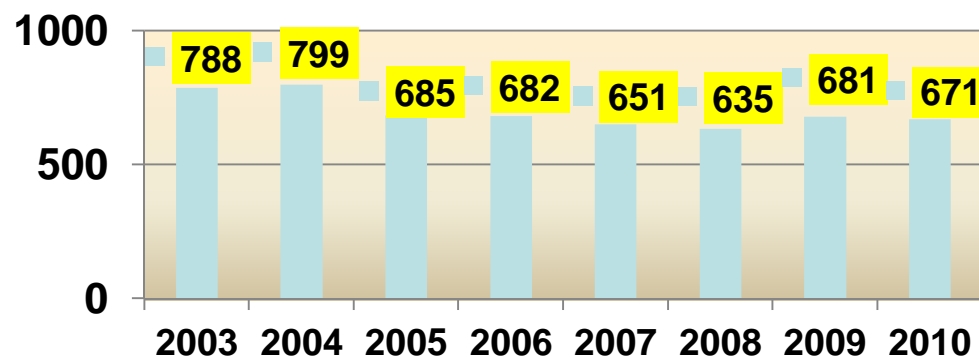
legislation imposed a duty on housing cooperatives to transfer the flat ownership to members free of charge if they request for the transfer

Numbers of units transferred into private ownership (from cca 700 000 units in administration of members of SCMBD)

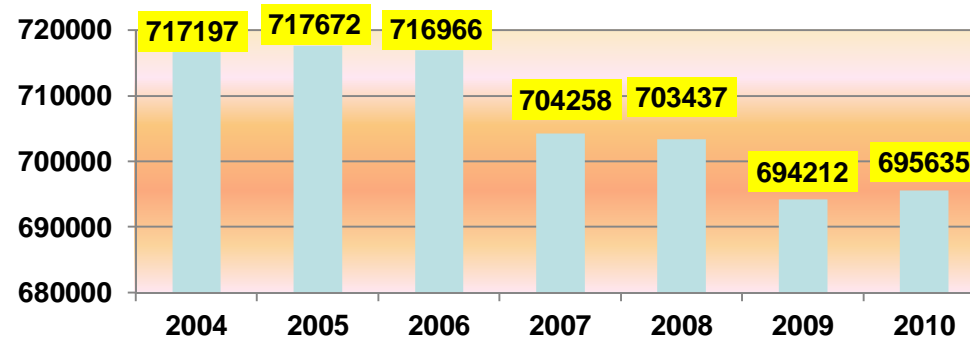


- ❑ is a special-interest organization of housing cooperatives in the Czech Republic;

(number of members of SCMBD)



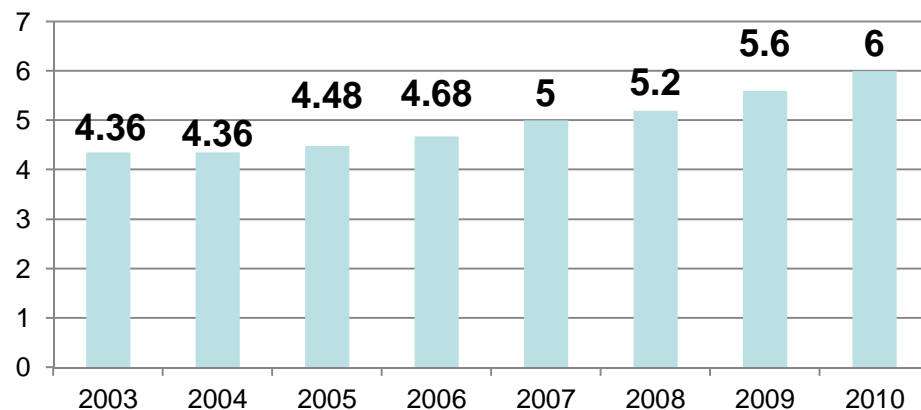
Development of managed units
(by members of SCMBD)



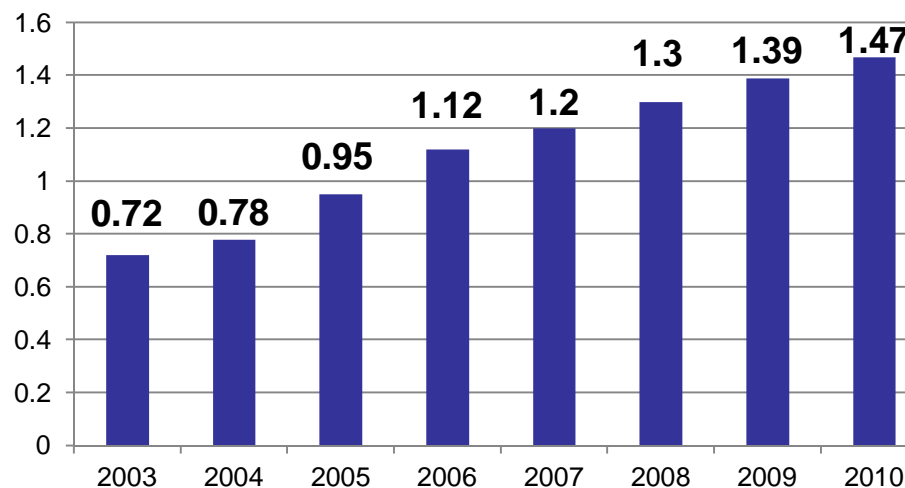
Union of czech and moravian housing co-operatives



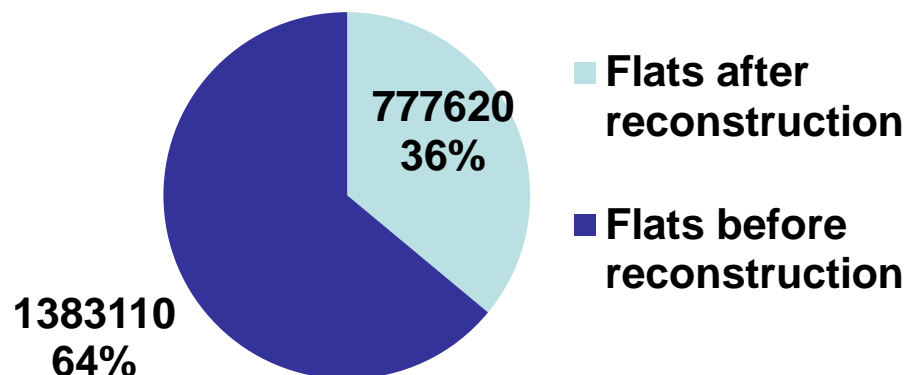
Monthly fee for managing – Eur/units



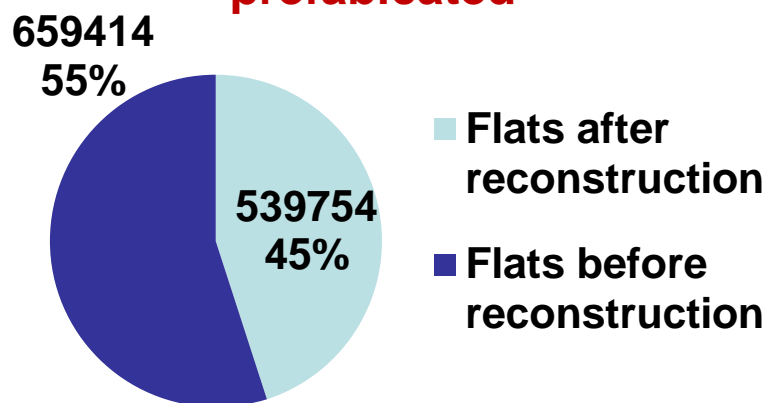
Average tariff of the deposit on long-term fund for reconstruction – Eur/month/m²



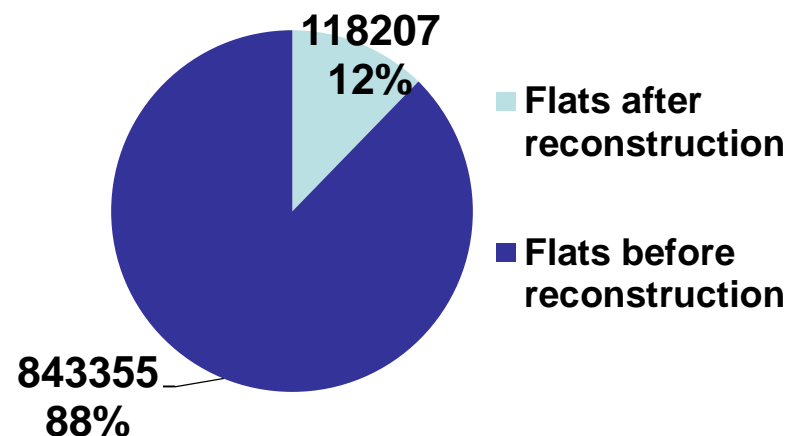
Housing blocks - total
