

Walkability, light exercise and well-being

- Walking, and other light exercise has overall benefits for the physical and mental well-being of especially elderly residents
- Planning the people flow inside the building can provide easy exercise possibilities throughout the year











Maker spaces

Tinkering and doing handicraft together is a good way to share knowledge and skills

- The laundry room can be extended by adding sewing and ironing possibilities
- Residents need **DIY spaces** to repair and upcycle
 e.g. furniture
- Recycling rooms are a good way to save resources













Assisted living networks

- All apartments are accessible
- We started promoting the distribution of assisted living units throughout our building as opposed to housing one big group home







- Understanding sharing economy




WHAT – The concept and architecture

- Generations block an accessible walkway, service centre and common yard
- Block coach person who works in the block and activates, encourages, motivates and supports the residents
- Final implementation with residents
- Sharing in the block skills, knowledge and passion of the residents





"Contents and walls" – at the same time








As a result: an old-fashion-modern city block

- Generations Block COMPLETED in March 2017

262 apartments and at least 400 inhabitants

- 102 rental apartments occupied mostly by students that live alone (HOAS)
- 47 owner-occupied apartments for the housing foundation HITAS – mostly for families (Asuntosäätiö / Asunto Oy Helsingin Hyväntoivonpuisto)
- 113 rental apartments
 (Setlementtiasunnot) for people of all
 ages. Also 20 of the apartments are
 reserved for wheelchair users. Validia
 Services is supporting their safe living and
 wellbeing.






A continuous walkway – the aorta of the living block


A continuous walkway, including resting places alongside






